RESULTS OF THE CONSULAR OUTREACH PROGRAM IN NORTH HILLS AND OAV REGISTRATION IN VAN NUYS

Los Angeles, 14 April 2009 – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles held a consular outreach program at the Seafood City, North Hills and Overseas Absentee Voters (OAV) field registration at the Church of God, Van Nuys on 21 and 28 March 2009, respectively.

A total of 93 consular services were provided including 31 OAV registration and 44 passport renewal while 36 registered for the 2010 elections in Van Nuys.

The North Hills outreach was undertaken in cooperation with the Seafood City Supermarket, 3MC and the San Fernando Valley Chamber of Commerce and the Van Nuys OAV field registration was made possible with the help of Ms. Mona Tabilisan and UNTV.

Both events are regular activities of the Consulate to bring its various services closer to its constituents residing in areas within its jurisdiction.###end
