RESULTS OF THE CONSULAR OUTREACH IN WALNUT, CA

Los Angeles, 1 June 2009 – Vice Consul John G. Reyes led a team from the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles and conducted a consular outreach program at the San Lorenzo Ruiz Catholic Parish Community in Walnut, CA on 30 May 2009.

A total of 87 consular services were rendered during the consular outreach, with the following breakdown:
