RESULTS OF THE CONSULAR OUTREACH IN ARIZONA

Los Angeles, 20 July 2009 – Vice Consul John G. Reyes led a team from the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles and conducted a consular outreach program at the Barrio Fiesta, Chandler, AZ on 18 July 2009.

The consular outreach program was undertaken in cooperation with *The Filipino American Journal*, *Philippine American Chamber of Commerce of Arizona*, and the *Filipino-American Sampaguita Club of Tucson*.

The following are the number of services rendered during the one-day program: renewal of passports (387), dual citizenship (57), replacement of loss passport (5), notarization of documents (16), civil registry (36), and visa issuance (1).

In addition, a total of 215 applicants signed up for Overseas Absentee Voting (OAV) registration.
