## **RESULTS OF THE CONSULAR OUTREACH IN NEW MEXICO**

Los Angeles, 11 August 2009 – Deputy Consul General Daniel R. Espiritu led a team from the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles and conducted a consular outreach program at the **Inn at Rio Rancho, NM** on 8 August 2009.

The consular outreach program was undertaken in cooperation with the ***Filipino American National Historical Society Rio Grande Chapter***.

The following are the number of services rendered during the two-day outreach program: renewal of passports (255), dual citizenship (23), replacement of loss passport (2), notarization of documents (7), civil registry (5), and visa issuance (1).

In addition, a total of 138 applicants signed up for Overseas Absentee Voting (OAV) registration.
