Los Angeles, 21 June 2010 – Consul General Mary Jo Bernardo Aragon led a team from the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles and conducted a consular outreach program at Bugsy’s located at the corner of W. Sahara Ave. and S. Jones Blvd., Las Vegas, Nevada on 19-20 June 2010.
