

AMBASSADOR JOSE L. CUISIA, JR. BIDS FAREWELL TO THE FILILPINO COMMUNITY IN LOS ANGELES

Los Angeles, 20 April 2016 – Ambassador Jose L. Cuisia, Jr. met with members of the Filipino American community of Los Angeles on 18 April 2016 to bid farewell.

During the meeting, Ambassador Cuisia shared his views on the incoming elections, and reflections on his 5-year tour of duty in the U.S. highlighting strengthened PH-US ties and successes of the Ambassadors Consuls General and Tourism Directors Tour (ACGTDT) and the Filipino American Youth Leadership Program (FYLPro). He had an informative discussion with the community on the Bangsamoro Basic Law (BBL), relief effort for Yolanda victims, healthcare in the Philippines, medical tourism, Conditional Cash Transfer (CCT) and immigration issues in the US. He cited the importance of the Filipino community in Los Angeles particularly their continued engagement in community programs. Ambassador Cuisia exhorted the community to cast their votes as early as possible.

Ambassador Cuisia assumed office as PH Ambassador to the U.S. on 02 April 2011. His tour of duty ends in June 2016.
