



RESULTS OF CONSULAR OUTREACH IN HOUSTON, TX

Los Angeles, 20 April 2016 – Consul Mary Joy Ramirez led a team from the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles that conducted a consular outreach program in Houston, TX on 16 to 17 April 2016.

The consular outreach program was undertaken in cooperation with Philippine Honorary Consul in Texas **Ethel Mercado** and the **Philippine American Chamber of Commerce of Texas (PACC Texas)** under the leadership of **Atty. Gary Ilagan**, State President and **Tess Tuazon**, Regional Chair.
