Los Angeles, 22 April 2016 – Consul General Leo Herrera-Lim paid a courtesy call on Los Angeles Police Department Charlie Beck on 19 April 2016 at the LAPD Headquarters.

The two officials discussed ways of further strengthening the cooperation between the LAPD and the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles, considering that Filipinos represent the second largest ethnic group in Los Angeles County.
