Los Angeles, 26 May 2016 - The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles hosted a welcome reception on 25 May 2016 in honor of the Philippine National Police (PNP) participants of the Public Safety Officers Senior Executive Course (PSEOSEC) Class 2016-93.
