Los Angeles, 24 August 2016 – Vice Consul Rainier Casis led a team from the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles that conducted a consular outreach program in Mesa, AZ on 20-21 August 2016.

The consular outreach program was undertaken in cooperation with the **Philippine American Chamber of Commerce of Arizona (PACCA)** and the **Filipino American Journal**.
