



RESULTS OF THE CONSULAR OUTREACH IN LAS VEGAS, NV

Los Angeles, 06 October 2016 – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles, led by Vice Consul Dyan Kristine Miranda-Pastrana led a three-day consular outreach program at Las Vegas, Nevada, U.S.A. on 24-26 September 2016.

The consular outreach program was undertaken in cooperation with the National Federation of Filipino American Associations (NaFFAA) Nevada under the leadership of **Mr. Bernie Benito**, Chairperson.



A total of 557 consular services were rendered during the consular outreach program, breakdown of which are as follows:
