Los Angeles, California, 11 October 2016 – As part of the City of Carson’s continuing celebration of Filipino-American History Month (FAHM), officials from the Philippine Consulate General participated with a Philippine booth at the event of the Filipino American Chamber of Commerce – South Bay Los Angeles Area (FACC-SLAA) on 08 October 2016 held at the SouthBay Pavilion Mall in Carson, California.

This event was initially celebrated by the City of Carson in October 2010. FACC-SLAA officially took over its organization in 2011. The celebration of FAHM at the SouthBay Pavilion Mall was a free event with live entertainment including singers, dancers, martial arts demonstration and magicians.
