



PHILCONGEN LOS ANGELES CONDUCTS CONSULAR OUTREACH IN NATIONAL CITY, CA

A team from the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles conducted a two-day consular outreach mission in National City, California on 28-29 January 2017.

The consular outreach mission was undertaken in cooperation with the Philippine Honorary Consulate in San Diego and in coordination with Operation Samahan and Council for Philippine American Organizations (COPAO).
