



## PHILCONGEN LOS ANGELES CONDUCTS CONSULAR OUTREACH IN HOUSTON, TEXAS

Los Angeles, 14 August 2017 – Vice Consul Rainier J. Casis led a consular outreach mission of the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles to Houston, Texas on 22 – 23 July 2017.
