Los Angeles, 15 August 2017 – Consul Rea G. Oreta led a consular outreach mission of the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles to Chandler, Arizona on 12 – 13 August 2017.

The Mission was undertaken in cooperation with the Philippine American Chamber of Commerce of Arizona through Mr. Leonardo O. Aromin, the Filipino-American Support Team of Arizona, the Bisaya Social Club of Arizona and Nanay’s Cuisine.
