The McAllen, TX Mobile Team renders Passport, Civil Registry, Dual Citizenship, Document Legalization and Overseas Voting Registration services.

Los Angeles, 12 September 2017 – Vice Consul Andrea Lynn N. Lazaro led a consular outreach mission of the Philippine Consulate General to McAllen, Texas from 09 to 10 September 2017.

The Mission was undertaken in cooperation with the Philippine American Chamber of Commerce in Texas - Rio Grande Valley (PACC-RGV) under the leadership of Honorary Consul Ethel Reyes-Mercado, PACC-RGV Regional Chair Merpu Roa and PACC-RGV Board Member Jennifer Cleveland.

A total of 342 consular and voter registration services were rendered during the two-day consular outreach mission, to wit:
