The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles wishes to express its heartfelt condolences to the families of the victims of the shooting which occurred in the Route 91 Harvest Festival in Las Vegas yesterday night, 01 October 2017, which has been identified as the deadliest shooting in modern U.S. history. Our prayers go to all those who were injured and to the police authorities and first responders who continue to endure the after-effects of the incident.
