Los Angeles, 31 October 2017 – Consul General Adelio Angelito S. Cruz attended the screening of the Philippine entry to the 3rd Asian World Film Festival (AWFF) at Arlight Cinema in Culver City on 27 October 2017. The AWFF aims to bring “the best of a broad selection of Asian World cinema to Los Angeles in order to draw greater recognition to the region’s wealth of filmmakers, strengthening ties between the Asian and Hollywood film industries.”

This year’s Festival has entries from over 50 countries, most of which were also submitted to the Academy of Motion Pictures Arts and Sciences and the Golden Globes for the Best Foreign Language Film category, in addition to other special screenings.

Birdshot, the Philippines’ entry to AWFF is a thriller film directed by Mikhail Red, produced by Pamela Red, and was co-produced by PelikulaRED, Tuko Film Productions, and Buchi Boy Productions. It was also selected as the Philippine entry for the Best Foreign Language Film at the 90th Academy Awards. END.
