Los Angeles, 27 February 2018 – Consul Ambrosio Brian F. Enciso III led a consular outreach mission of the Philippine Consulate General to Houston, Texas from 24 to 25 February 2018.

The Mission was undertaken in cooperation with the Philippine American Chamber of Commerce of Texas (PACC Texas) led by President, Atty.
