



## Philippine Overseas Voters Registration Process Resumes in Los Angeles

The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles, as deputized by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC), is resuming the continuing registration for Overseas Voters for the May 2019 Philippine elections for Senators and Party-List Representatives.

The registration process will begin on **01 December 2016** and will last until **30 September 2018**.

Registration will be conducted at the premises of the Consulate General, 3435 Wilshire Blvd., Suite 550, Los Angeles California 90010 from **9:00 am - 12:00 nn and 1:00 pm - 5:00 pm**

Registration will also be conducted in various mobile sites during the Consulate General's consular outreach activities in order to reach as many of our *kababayans* living in the southwestern United States as possible.

Filipino citizens residing abroad who are not yet registered as overseas voters, and intend to vote during the May 2019 Philippine elections, may file their applications for registration.

The requirements for registration are as follows:

1. Accomplished Registration Form (OVF #1) (Please see link below for Form);
2. Original and copy of your valid Philippine Passport;
3. For dual citizens, original and photocopy of your dual citizenship Identification Certificate and Order of Approval issued by the Philippine Embassy or Philippine Consulate General or Philippine Bureau of Immigration.

The exercise of continuing registration for Overseas Voting is being done pursuant to Republic Act No. 9189, otherwise known as "The Overseas Absentee Voting Act of 2003," as amended by Republic Act No. 10590.
