Los Angeles, 15 January 2019 – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles, represented by Consul Rea Oreta, led the 29<sup>th</sup> induction ceremony of the 2019-2020 officers of the Naga City USA (NCUSA) at the residence of its new president, Ms. Zeny Sabocor, on 13 January 2019.

In her remarks, Consul Oreta, commended the Association for maintaining ties and consistently sharing their blessings with their kababayans in their hometown. She also encouraged the Association to include in its advocacies Filipino-American youth empowerment both in Los Angeles and Naga.
