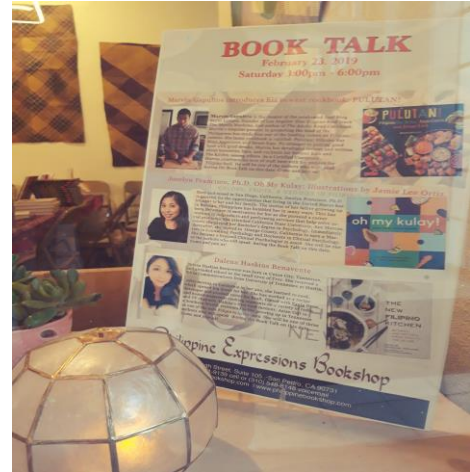




## LA PCG Supports the Event Featuring Books on Filipino Cuisine
