2019 National and Local Elections

13 April - 13 May 2019

Can I vote?

If you are an active and registered voter under the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles you can vote in this election. Click [here](#) to find your name in the COMELEC's Certified List of Overseas Voters for the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles.

Where and when can I vote?

For the 2019 National and Local Elections under the jurisdiction of the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles, **voting will be done by mail.**

If you are included in COMELEC's Certified List of Overseas Voters for the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles, expect to receive your mailing packet containing your ballot and other necessary election paraphernalia in the coming days.

There will be no voting in person at the Consulate General for the 2019 National and Local Elections.

How can I send back my ballot?

You can mail the ballot placed inside the official ballot envelope back to the Consulate General. The voter will shoulder the cost of postage.

You may also opt to hand carry the ballot back to the Consulate General, again sealed in the official ballot envelope.

The Consulate General can receive hand-carried ballots Mondays to Fridays during office hours (i.e. 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. L.A. Time) for the duration of the election period.

Only valid ballots **received by 13 May 2019 (6:00 p.m. Manila Time)** can be included in the count.

The mailing packet you will receive will not only contain your ballot and the other necessary election paraphernalia, but will also contain a sheet of instructions for overseas voters. Please follow these instructions closely.
