



ADVISORY ON 04 JULY 2019 EARTHQUAKE IN SOUTHERN CA

The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles advises all Filipinos and Filipino-Americans within its jurisdiction that as of 1800 HRS (Pacific Standard Time), approximately 7.5 hours after the 6.4-magnitude earthquake hit various parts of southern California and Nevada, there has, as yet, still been no reported injuries or casualties involving Filipino nationals or Filipino-Americans.

There has also been no reports of significant structural or infrastructure damage in L.A. county. The Los Angeles International Airport released a statement saying all runways were inspected with no reported damage to the airfield or the Sepulveda Tunnel and airport operations remain normal.

The Consulate General continues to monitor the situation and is coordinating with Filipino-American community organizations, as well as concerned U.S. government agencies.

The Filipino-American community is strongly encouraged to take precautions during emergencies. *Kababayans* may wish to download the app called ShakeAlertLA on their smartphones. Said app warns of any possible earthquake detected within the area of the user.
