



## Palace Entertainment Executives Call on Consul General Cruz

28 June 2019, Los Angeles - Executives of a US-based entertainment and amusement company, Palace Entertainment, led by its Fil-Am Vice President for Food and Beverage, Mr. Albert L. Palace Entertainment, which is headquartered in Newport Beach, CA, is one of the largest operators of water parks, theme parks and family entertainment centers in the United States.
