28 October 2019, Los Angeles – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles conducted a consular outreach mission in San Diego from 26 to 27 October 2019 with Consul Rea G. Oreta at the helm. The Consulate General partnered with the Philippine Honorary Consulate in San Diego and the Council of Philippine American Organizations (COPAO).

This is the Consulate General's 3rd consular outreach in San Diego for this year, which aims to bring its various consular services closer to more than 158,000 Filipinos and Filipino-Americans residing in San Diego County and nearby counties in Southern California.
