



ADVISORY 28 ON THE 2019 NOVEL CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19)

COVID-19 cases in Southern California, Southern Nevada, and Arizona <i>(as of 30 April 2020)</i>	
• Southern California:	37,678 COVID-19 cases with 1,565 deaths
• Southern Nevada:	3,979 COVID-19 cases with 202 deaths
• State of Arizona:	7,962 COVID-19 cases with 330 deaths

The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles reiterates that **all Filipinos** arriving from overseas, **both OFWs and non-OFWs, shall undergo 14-day quarantine and rapid antibody testing for COVID-19** upon arrival in the Philippines.

CALIFORNIA

- Childcare portal – The portal provides a list of local center-based and family child care programs by simply inputting your locations and the type of care you need.

- CalFresh Program – A program that provides monthly benefits to assist low-income households in purchasing the food. California Governor Gavin Newsom has expanded the program allowing the participants to use their Pandemic Emergency Benefits Transfer Program (P-EBT) card to purchase groceries online at Amazon.com and Walmart.com.
