



TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ISSUANCE OF PHILIPPINE VISA

Affected by the Suspension (effective 22 March 2020)

All foreign nationals, including those who have already been issued a 9(a) Temporary Visitor/Tourist Visa

All foreigners with visa-free privileges per Visa Waiver Agreements and Executive Order 408, s. 1960

Holders of Hong Kong and Macau SAR passports

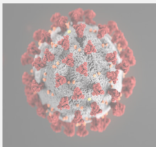
Holders of Macau-Portuguese and British National Overseas passports

Exempted from the suspension

Foreign nationals who are already in the Philippines or holders of visas issued by other Philippine government agencies

Foreign spouses and children of Filipino nationals who are traveling with the Filipino national and fall under Executive Order 408 (non-visa required nationals)

Visas previously issued to accredited officials of Foreign Government and International Organizations, as well as the dependents of these officials



Said suspension is in compliance with

Philippine Presidential Proclamation No. 929, Declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Coronavirus Disease & Philippine Presidential Proclamation No. 922, Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency to the Philippines
