



ADVISORY 23 ON THE 2019 NOVEL CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19)

COVID-19 cases in Southern California, Southern Nevada, and Arizona*(as of 19 April 2020)*

- **Southern California:** 21,909 COVID-19 cases with 859 deaths
- **Southern Nevada:** 2,940 COVID-19 cases with 137 deaths
- **State of Arizona:** 4,929 COVID-19 cases with 184 deaths

The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles informs Filipinos and Filipino-Americans residing in Southern California, Southern Nevada and Arizona that the “**stay-at-home**” orders issued by your respective States remain in effect.

Our *kababayan* are also reminded that the **Enhanced Community Quarantine in Luzon, Philippines remains in effect through 30 April 2020.**

Resolutions 23 and 24 on the 14-day quarantine order for all OFWs including cruise ship crews, issued by the Philippine Government’s Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) on 13 and 14 April 2020, respectively, **also remain in place.** For our detailed advisory on the matter, please click the link:
