



## ADVISORY 6 ON THE 2019 NOVEL CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19)

The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles once again reminds all Filipinos and Filipino-Americans within its consular jurisdiction who wishes to travel outside of the United States to visit the following link for U.S. travel advisories: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers/index.html>.

As of this writing, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that travelers avoid nonessential travel to South Korea and the People's Republic of China (this does not include Hong Kong, Macau, or the island of Taiwan). CDC issued Warning Level 3 as the COVID-19 is causing an outbreak of respiratory illness in South Korea.
