Suspension of all Commercial / Passenger Flights to and from the Philippines

The Philippine Consulate General informs Filipinos and Filipino-Americans and other prospective travelers to the Philippines in Southern California, Southern Nevada and Arizona that the Philippine Government has **temporarily suspended all commercial/passenger flights to and from the Philippines beginning 03 May 2020.**

Repatriation of Overseas Filipino Workers is also temporarily suspended.

All domestic arrivals and departures at Manila's Ninoy Aquino International Airport also remain temporarily suspended.

Cargo flights, medical supplies, utility and maintenance flights will remain unhampered.

The **new flight restriction is only temporary and will be implemented for one week** to give the government the opportunity to decongest quarantine facilities in Metro Manila.
