

**ADVISORY 35 ON THE 2019 NOVEL CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19)****COVID-19 cases in Southern California, Southern Nevada, and Arizona***(as of 17 May 2020)*

- **Southern California:** 62,107 COVID-19 cases with 2,592 deaths
- **Southern Nevada:** 5,366 COVID-19 cases with 296 deaths
- **State of Arizona:** 13,937 COVID-19 cases with 680 deaths

The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles would like to inform Filipinos and Filipino-Americans in the States of California, Nevada and Arizona that their respective States have published **industry-specific guidelines** for the implementation of the first phase of their respective reopening plans. Filipinos and Filipino-Americans, who are clients, business-owners or are stakeholders in any of the industries that have begun reopening are reminded to keep themselves informed of said guidelines for their own benefit and protection. Local officials update the guidelines from time to time.

Residents of L.A. County are advised that the County order dubbed “**Continuation of Safer at Home Order that Begins to Move the County of Los Angeles into Stage 2 of County’s Roadmap to Recovery**” and the City’s corresponding modification of its “Stay at Home” Order **did not relax orders** for individual social distancing measures.

Local residents are **still required** to wear **face masks** whenever in public; **stay home** whenever possible, especially those over 65 years of age and with chronic underlying conditions; **wash their hands frequently**; and maintain **six feet-distance** from others whenever outside of their home.
