ADVISORY ON EXERCISING INCREASED CAUTION AND VIGILANCE AMIDST PROTEST ACTIONS IN THE UNITED STATES

The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles urges all Filipinos and Filipino-Americans within its jurisdiction to exercise increased caution and vigilance in order to ensure their safety and wellbeing amidst escalating protest actions and incidences of unrest in various cities in the United States.

Filipinos are strongly advised to adhere to curfews and other security measures imposed by local authorities; avoid areas of unrest; be aware of their surroundings and any crowd build-ups that may lead to disturbances (looting, destruction of property, etc.); and monitor their respective local news for the latest information.

The Consulate General has so far not received any report of Filipinos who have been hurt or injured due to the protests.

Filipinos are also strongly encouraged to abide by existing medical advisories on social distancing and the wearing of face masks in public areas on account of the current COVID-19 pandemic.
