Travel Advisory in California

The State issued a Travel Advisory on 13 November 2020, recommending that travelers from other States or countries, including returning Californians, to **observe 14-day self-quarantine while limiting interactions with their immediate household.** The advisory further indicates that **Californians should avoid non-essential travel**, which is defined as for tourism or recreational purposes.
