ADVISORY NATIONAL TERRORISM ADVISORY SYSTEM

The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles informs all Filipinos and Filipino-Americans in Southern California, Southern Nevada, and the State of Arizona that the U.S. Department of Homeland Security issued a National Terrorism Advisory System (NTAS) Bulletin, which took effect on 27 January 2021 and will expire on 30 April 2021, owing to a heightened threat environment across the United States, following the Presidential Inauguration.

The Bulletin stipulates, *“information suggests that some ideologically-motivated violent extremists with objections to the exercise of governmental authority and the presidential transition, as well as other perceived grievances fueled by false narratives, could continue to mobilize to incite or commit violence.”*
