08 March 2021, Los Angeles – The Department of Information and Communication Technology (DICT), in collaboration with the Healthcare Information Management Association of the Philippines (HIMAP), held the second installment of its webinar series, entitled “*Global HIMS Powered by PH: A Two-Part Webinar Series focusing on Philippine HIMS BPM Services*” on 17 February 2021.

The session began with opening remarks delivered by DICT Director Emmy Lou Delfin who announced that the government will continue to hold online activities to attract potential investors and to capacitate PHL labor force.

A talk on the impact of information technology on healthcare was then delivered by Mr. Vincent M. Remo, Vice President for Innovation and Development of Advanced World Systems, Inc.

In particular, he discussed “Data Analytics (DA) Services and Solutions,” which facilitate customer intelligence gathering, and a “cloud-based collaboration platform,” which allow HIMS companies to share information and coordinate healthcare management.
