CONGEN BADAJOS MEETS L.A. COUNTY CHIEF OF PROTOCOL

13 May 2021, Los Angeles – Consul General Edgar B. Badajos virtually called on Los Angeles County Chief of Protocol, Ms. Lourdes Saab, in the afternoon of 12 May 2021 via Microsoft Teams. Also present during the virtual call was the Consulate General’s Information Officer, Mary Grace D. Leaño.

During the call, the two officials discussed various topics, including LA county’s organizational structure and functions, the role of the Chief of Protocol relative to the County and the Consular Corps, the improving CoViD-19 pandemic situation in the County, the County’s public health system and available healthcare services to foreign nationals, law enforcement protocols, racial equity, and holding cultural events in L.A.

Consul General Badajos thanked Ms. Saab for always looking after the needs of the consular corps, especially at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic last year.

Los Angeles has the world’s third largest consular corps (after New York and Hong Kong), consisting of over 100 countries represented in the County. END.
