## PHILCONGEN LA REPRISSES OUTREACH IN LAS VEGAS OVER 630 CONSULAR CLIENTS SERVED



12 July 2021, Los Angeles – Cognizant of the growing consular needs of the Filipino-American community in Southern Nevada, the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles conducted its second consular and assistance-to-nationals outreach mission to Las Vegas, NV from 10 to 11 July 2021. The outreach mission, the Consulate General's third overall for the year, was conducted in collaboration with the National Federation of Filipino American Associations led by its President, Ms. Cynthia G. Deriquito.

The team rendered a total of 637 consular services, including ePassport issuance (256 clients), dual citizenship petitions (108 clients), civil registry (five clients), consular notarization (58 clients), as well as Overseas Voting Registration (210 clients). Also present was the Consulate General's Assistance-to-Nationals team, which provided various assistance to Filipino nationals in distress, and conducted a Post-Arrival Orientation Seminar or PAOS for nine Filipino teachers, working in Clark County, NV under the Exchange Visitor or J-1 visa Program.

This outreach mission in Las Vegas comes just two months after the Consulate General's first post-pandemic outreach mission to the same City on 01-02 May 2021 and is part of Consul General Edgar B. Badajos' commitment to intensify outreach missions outside of



Los Angeles County to make up for the Consulate General's reduced operating capacity 2020 and early 2021 due to the CoViD-19 pandemic.

The Philippine Overseas Labor Office- Los Angeles also joined the outreach.
