21 July 2021, Los Angeles – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles conducted its first consular and assistance-to-nationals outreach mission to San Diego, CA for the year, from 17 to 18 July 2021. The outreach mission, the Consulate General’s fourth overall in 2021, was conducted in collaboration with the Council of Philippine American Organizations (COPAO) and Filipino American Chamber of Commerce, North County (FACC-NC) through its Chairman Mr. Joseph Mazares and its President Ms. Femie Cupit, respectively.

The team led by Consul General Edgar B. Badajos rendered a total of 626 consular services, including ePassport issuance (226 clients), dual citizenship petitions (89

clients), civil registry (one client), consular notarization (25), as well as Overseas Voting Registration (190). Also present in San Diego was the Consulate General's Assistance-to-Nationals team, which provided financial assistance to an overseas Filipinos in the region.

This outreach mission to San Diego is part of Consul General Edgar B. Badajos' commitment to intensify outreach missions outside of Los Angeles County to make up for the Consulate General's reduced operating capacity in 2020 and early 2021 due to the CoViD-19 pandemic.

The Philippine Trade and Investment Center-Los Angeles (PTIC-LA), Philippine Department of Tourism-Los Angeles (PDOT-LA), Office of the Police Attache-Liaison Office on the United States West Coast (OPALOWC), Philippine Overseas Labor Office-Los Angeles (POLO-LA), and Social Services System (SSS) Representative also joined the mission as well.
