## **ADVISORY 47 ON THE 2019 NOVEL CORONAVIRUS**

27 July 2021 – In view of the resurgence of CoViD-19 cases due to highly transmissible B.1.617.2 or “Delta” Variant, the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles strongly advises Filipinos and Filipino-Americans in **Southern California, Southern Nevada and State of Arizona** of the following:

### ***Avail of CoViD-19 Vaccines***

### ***Mask Requirements Regardless of Vaccination Status***

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recently announced that **people who live in high-transmission communities wear masks in indoor public spaces, even if they have already been vaccinated.** The CDC likewise recommended that **vaccinated people with vulnerable household members,** including young children and those who are immunocompromised, **wear masks indoors in public spaces.**

### ***Abide By Updated Guidance***

State of California – *“All state workers and workers in health care and high-risk congregate settings to either show proof of full vaccination or be tested at least once per week, and our encouragement of all local government and other employers to adopt a similar protocol.”*
