29 September 2021, Los Angeles – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles conducted its first consular outreach mission to Palm Springs, CA for the year, from 25 to 26 September 2021. This outreach mission, the Consulate General’s eighth overall in 2021, was conducted in collaboration with the National Alliance of Filipino-Americans (NAFA) through its president, Ms. Isabel Chapman.

The team led by Consul General Edgar B. Badajos rendered a total of 575 consular services, including ePassport issuance (239 clients), dual citizenship petitions (113 clients), civil registry (2 reports), consular notarization (26 documents), as well as overseas voting (OV) registration (195 registrants).

This outreach mission to Palm Springs is part of Consul General Edgar B. Badajos’ strategy to maintain a broad and diverse set of destinations for consular outreach missions, ensuring that Filipino-Americans in all corners of the Consulate General’s jurisdiction are better served.

The outreach team included Vice Consul Joan Macrise C. Corrado (signing officer); Linda H. Cadiang (cashier); Salvador P. Marzo, Maria Carlota A. Tamayo, Jonathan Heartchie M. Tamayo (passport encoders); Jay B. Perez (dual citizenship processor); Juliet F. Araña-Oresca (notarization and civil registry processor); Judelyn M. Cuaresma (OV registration); and Ms. Mary Grace D. Leaño (Information Officer).

On the sidelines of the outreach mission, Consul General Badajos was interviewed by NBC Palm Springs, TFC's Balitang America, ANC News Worldwide, Asian Journal, and Hemet Times; conducted a Town Hall Meeting with local Fil-Am Community Leaders; and visited a number of Fil-Am owned businesses.
