PHILCONGEN LA 3rd OUTREACH MISSION TO ARIZONA ABOUT 380 CONSULAR SERVICES RENDERED



15 November 2021, Los Angeles – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles conducted a consular outreach mission to Phoenix, AZ from 13 to 14 November 2021 at the Sonesta Select Camelback Hotel. The Consulate held the mission in cooperation with the Council of Filipino Organizations in AZ (CFO-AZ) through its President, Ms. Alma De Garriz, with the support of other Filipino-American community leaders, members and donors who selflessly volunteered their invaluable time, talents and resources to make the public service project for Filipinos in Arizona.

The team, led by Deputy CG Ambrosio Brian F. Enciso III rendered a total of 377 consular services during the two-day mission, including ePassport issuance (233 clients), dual citizenship petitions (74 applicants), civil registry (eight reports), as well as consular notarization (62 documents).

This is the Consulate General's 3rd consular outreach to Phoenix and 10th conducted overall for the year 2021 in fulfillment of the directives set by Consul General Edgar B. Badajos to reduce the buildup of underserved consular clients across the Consulate General's jurisdiction as a result of the global CoViD-19 pandemic by intensifying the conduct of outreach missions after the resumption of such services in May 2021.
