PhilConGen LA Visits Filipinos in NV Jail



10 March 2022, Las Vegas, Nevada – Continuing their multi-day mission in southern Nevada, the Assistance-to-Nationals (ATN) Team of the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles visited three Filipina inmates who are serving their respective sentences at the Florence McClure Women Correctional Center.
