21 March 2022, Los Angeles – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles conducted its first consular outreach mission to Las Vegas, NV for the year, from 19 to 20 March 2022. This outreach mission, the Consulate General’s second overall in 2022, was conducted in collaboration with the Fil Am Civic Action International (FACAI) through its President Ms. Asela Engel.

The team rendered a total of 534 consular services, including ePassport issuance (308 clients), dual citizenship petitions (129 clients), civil registry (13 clients), and consular notarization (84 documents).

This outreach mission to Las Vegas is part of Consul General Edgar B. Badajos’ commitment to extend consular services to even more Filipinos and Filipino-Americans living and working in southern California, southern Nevada and the State of Arizona. Such outreach missions take away the need for consular clients to make the long journey to the City of Los Angeles where the Consulate General is located.

The outreach team was led by Vice Consul Joan Macrise C. Corrado (signing officer); and included Linda H. Cadiang (cashier); Judelyn M. Cuaresma, Jonathan Heartchie M. Tamayo, Maria Carlota A. Tamayo (passport encoders); Ruby R. Aquino (dual citizenship processor); and Edgar B. Guinto (notarization and civil registry processor).
