FILM DEVT COUNCIL OF THE PHILIPPINES EXEC EXPLAINS COUNCIL PROGRAMS TO FILIPINX FILMMAKERS

27 March 2022, Los Angeles – Film Development Council of the Philippines (FDCP) Undersecretary Mary Liza Diño recently with executives of Cinema Sala to explain FDCP’s programs that are available to Filipino filmmakers and producer. According to its website (www.cinemasala.org), LA-based Cinema Sala is “a platform showcasing Filipino and Filipino-American work in film and the performing arts through programming, distribution, and education.”

During the meeting, Undersecretary Dino likewise elaborated on FDCP’s plans for a business-to-business matching event for Philippine films sometime in May 2022 to give Filipino film and TV producers a platform to pitch their projects to major distributors and streaming companies in the U.S., including Netflix and Amazon. She also highlighted FDCP’s activities in promoting the Philippines as a filming location to foreign film and TV producers.

Philippine Tourism Representative, Mr. Richmond Patrick Jimenez, and Cultural Officer Ms. Joy Ellen B. France attended the meeting on behalf of the Philippine Consulate General in LA. END.
