KALAYAAN 2022 CELEBRATED IN LOS ANGELES

15 June 2022, Los Angeles – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles held a formal reception in commemoration of the 124th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence on 14 June 2019 at the Carson Event Center in the City of Carson, CA. The reception is the Consulate General's first-ever post-pandemic, in person Independence reception, Day together diplomats, local government officials Filipino-American community business leaders, numbering more than 200 in all.

In his toast remarks, the Consul General underscored the significance of the event and the venue of the celebration. Carson is not only home to a large number of Filipino-Americans and Filipino-owned businesses; it is also the location of the largest monument dedicated to national hero Dr. Jose P. Rizal on the United States West Coast. The larger than life-sized statue was formally unveiled in September 2012.

In line with this year's Independence Day theme, "Kalayaan 2022: Pagsuong sa Hamon ng Panibagong Bukas", ConGen Badajos highlighted the outgoing administration's major milestones, such as the expansion of universal healthcare and free tertiary education, tax reform, business-friendly legislation, and transportation and infrastructure modernization through the "Build, Build, Build" program, among others.
