## PHILCONGEN LA CONDUCTS CONSULAR OUTREACH IN PALM SPRINGS



22 July 2022, Los Angeles – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles sent a consular outreach mission to Palm Springs, CA from 16 to 17 July 2022. The outreach mission, held at the Palm Springs Leisure Center, was the Consulate General's sixth overall in 2022. This public service was made possible by the invaluable assistance and cooperation of the National Alliance of Filipino Americans led by its president, Ms. Isabel Trinidad Chapman.

The team rendered a total of 335 consular services over the two-day mission, including ePassport issuance (142 applicants), dual citizenship (112 petitions), civil registry (10 reports) and consular notarization (71 documents).

Additionally, a Town Hall meeting with the Filipino-American community was held on 15 July 2022 at the same venue. The event, also attended by Palm Springs Mayor ProTem Grace Garner, was an opportunity for the community to ask questions about the functions and programs of the Consulate General under the leadership of Consul General Edgar B. Badajos, as well as specific consular issues they have.

The outreach team was led by Consul Francis Maynard S. Maleon (signing officer), and included Ms. Linda H. Cadiang (cashier); Ms. Ma. Czarina Brenda L. Villatito, Ms. Annabelle R. Sagum (passport encoders); Ms. Hazel SJ Manahan-Mendoza (passport processor); Ms. Joy Ellen B. France (dual citizenship processor) and Mr. Edgardo C. Lim (notarization and civil registry processor).
